

GPNW Mission Center Conference 2012: World Conference and USA National Conference Delegate Expectations



Delegates to the 2013 World Conference and USA National Conference will be selected in two separate elections with two different ballots. We will be electing 84 delegates for World Conference and 71 delegates to USA National Conference. In electing delegates to each conference, a plurality vote is considered sufficient for election with the alternates being ranked according to the number of votes each received. A person can be elected to serve as a delegate or alternate of one or both conferences. It is not a requirement to be a delegate at both conferences.

Delegates/alternates should be members in good standing with their membership recorded in the mission center.

An effort should be made to elect delegates/alternates that represent mission center membership based on

- Age
- Congregational membership
- Gender
- Priesthood

- Theme: Christ's Mission, Our Mission—Let's Take the Next Step
- Read book from Herald House—*Christ's Mission is Our Mission*

USA National Conference Expectations

- Theme: Together in Christ—A Journey of Faith
- Participate in individual, small-group, and large-group experiences that used resources created to prepare the body to be open to discovering God's will. These resources are available on the USA National Conference web pages and include

- ◇ Questions and Reflections: Journeying in Faith. Youth and adult spiritual practices about relationships for individual and small-group use.
- ◇ Wholeness in Christ: Balance and Connections. Six-session adult study on selected Enduring Principles and the relationship principles in Doctrine and Covenants 164:6a.
- ◇ The Role of Scripture in Discovering God's Will. Adult DVD class with facilitator and participant guides.
- ◇ Signal Communities: Six-session adult study on selected Enduring Principles and what creates a signal community.
- Practice "holy indifference," which asks them to "surrender their perceptions, opinions, and agendas of the self (the individual ego) to the mind and heart of God, the Source of all truth, wisdom, and beauty."
- Participate in the Fall "Discerning God's Will" workshops being held in October; dates and locations can be found on the GPNW Mission Center website.
- Participate in one of three preparatory workshops within the GPNW Mission Center, to be held in February and March. Dates are tentatively set as Feb. 23, March 2 and March 20, locations to be announced.
